ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR ANAND DEVA

Associate Professor Anand Deva's clinical practice covers a broad spectrum and includes cosmetic surgery of the face and body, reconstructive facial surgery, elective and acute hand surgery and reconstructive microsurgery.

He graduated from the University of Sydney in 1991 with Class 1 Honours and was awarded the University Medal in Medicine. After completing internship and residency at the Royal Prince Alfred Hospital, he was admitted into advanced training in general surgery in 1994 and completed a Masters of Surgery in 1996. He commenced advanced training in Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery in 1996 and obtained his fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons (FRACS) in 2000. He has received numerous awards and prizes that recognise his contribution to research and teaching.

Professor Deva will provide an update on facial rejuvenation - surgical and non-surgical options.

DR STEVE MERTEN

Dr Steve Merten is a fully qualified Plastic Surgeon who specialises in cosmetic plastic surgery, with major interests in cosmetic breast surgery, facial surgery and body contouring surgery. Dr Merten studied Medicine at the University of Sydney, then went on to complete training in Plastic Surgery, and was admitted as a Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons (FRACS) in 2001. At the completion of his Plastic Surgery training, Dr Merten spent a further year as a Fellow in Breast Reconstruction at the University of British Columbia, Canada, and as a Fellow in Aesthetic Surgery at the Melbourne Institute of Plastic Surgery and Monash University. Dr Merten is actively involved in teaching plastic surgery to the next generation of surgeons.

Dr Merten will be discussing surgical anatomy of the breast, aesthetic breast problems, surgical options in aesthetic breast surgery, risks and complications in breast surgery and avoidance and future technologies in breast surgery.

DR GAZI HUSSAIN

Dr Gazi Hussain is a Specialist Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeon with primary interests in cosmetic surgery, facial and breast surgery, microsurgery and skin cancer surgery.

He attended the University of New South Wales and after graduating with an MB BS degree he undertook 10 years of training in surgery which culminated in 1999 with being awarded a Fellowship in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery from the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons. Dr Hussain then elected to spend a year in Toronto, Canada to undertake further advanced training in facial paralysis surgery, cosmetic surgery and microsurgery. Dr Hussain is one of Australia's leading experts on facial reanimation surgery and has published papers and presented at international meetings.

Dr Hussain will be discussing nasal reconstruction.

DR PETER VICKERS

Dr Peter Vickers trained in Medicine and Dentistry, surgical training in Australia, the USA and the UK. He is an Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon with a particular interest in oral pathology and trauma with an emphasis on oral cancer and the reconstruction of the jaw and teeth.

Dr Vickers has managed significant sporting injuries to the face and teeth. He utilises the most current methods of diagnosis and treatment.

Dr Vickers will be speaking on oral pathology, dental disease and out-patient management of facial trauma.
